AS A PARENT OR SCHOOL ADMINISTRATOR, HOW WOULD YOU ANSWER THESE IMPORTANT QUESTIONS ABOUT YOUR SCHOOL'S SAFETY?

1 Vulnerability

Has your school had a threat vulnerability assessment conducted by a protective security professional?

2 Advanced Training

Is your school's active shooter training evidence-based and delivered by mental health and security experts with a professional development CEU award?

3 Frequency

Is threat prevention part of your school's daily duties or is it an afterthought?

4 Classroom Lockdown Devices

Are classroom doors protected with push button deadbolt devices?

5 Lockdown

Does your school understand and practice proper lockdown protocol and do they have the required equipment?

6 Protocol

Does your school have a best practice-based active shooter protocol in its Emergency Action Plan?

7 Stop the Bleed

Does your school have the required stop the bleed equipment in every classroom, school bus, and wall mounted units, accompanied by a user app?

8 Accreditation

Is your school's active shooter training accredited with a professional development CEU?

9 Special Needs

Does your plan have provisions for special needs students?

10 Communication

What is the protocol for communication with parents and reunification after an emergency?
